Swedish has the same twenty-six letters that English does, with an additional three—å, ä, and ö. These are added to the list of vowels, along with y, making a total of nine vowels. “A” is pronounced differently depending upon whether it is long or short. When long, it is pronounced like the “a” in far.

Introduction: Swedish is a member of the Germanic branch of the Indo-European family and therefore shares close ties with English.Swedes tend to learn English relatively easily.
